



CVS/pharmacy Challenge Volunteer Application

No Golf Knowledge Required

Admissions Credentials: (Monday-Sunday) Chair Person: Bob Burns - Located offsite at Bishop Ranch (spectator and volunteer parking lot), meet and greet fans, sell tickets, administer will call.

Caddies: (Monday-Sunday) Chair Person: Larry Wagner - Assist with the supervision of caddie assignments and organization.

Carts and Shuttling: (Tuesday-Sunday) Chair Person: Dave Marshburn - Manage carts and shuttle LPGA players as necessary. If possible, we ask you to work all day.

Driving Range: (Monday-Sunday) Chairs: Douglas and Susan Leurey - Assist LPGA players at the driving range, replenish balls and set up hitting stations. (*Limited Space Available*)

Facilities/Operations/Signage: (Pre, during and post tournament) Chair Person: Acey Hannam - Build the tournament from the ground up!! Assemble, construct and repair tournament facilities. Maintain and operate tournament equipment. Working knowledge of tools a must. Distribute, install and maintain signs on and off the course. Remove, inventory and store signs as needed.

Locker Room: (Monday-Sunday) Chair Person: Jan Stallman - Female volunteers needed to help manage LPGA player lounge/locker room. Distribute packages, deliver phone messages and post notices. *Limited Space Available*

Marshals: (Thursday-Sunday) Chairs: Gil Gordon and Don Scellato - Provide control over that gallery at tees, greens and fairways. Responsible for ball spotting, rope and gate maintenance. This is a standing or sitting position (bring your own small chair if you would like). If possible, we ask you to work all day. (*Training Required*)

Player Transportation: (Saturday pre-tournament through Monday post) Transport players in courtesy cars as needed. Must have clean driving record and be 25 years of age or older. A clear photocopy of driver's license must be submitted with your application.

Pro-ams: (Pre-tournament, Monday-Wednesday) - Inventory, pack gift bags and coordinate Tuesday's Draw Party. Register and assist VIP participants on Monday and Wednesday, early morning shifts.

Product Delivery: (Monday-Sunday) Chairs: Mike Moore and Andy Kingsbury - Deliver drinks and ice to tournament venues, including hospitality tents and players lounge. Must be able to lift 20 pounds. Most shifts early AM and early evening.

Security: (Monday-Sunday) Chair Person: Ed Fisher - Provide security and crowd control in various locations including: clubhouse, skyboxes, hospitality tents and other necessary locations as directed.

VIP Hospitality: (Thursday-Sunday) Chair Person: Ed Fisher - Welcome VIPs to hospitality areas, including skyboxes, hospitality tents and the clubhouse. Provide set up, access control and oversee food and beverage supply.

Standard Bearer: (Thursday-Sunday) Chair Person: Bill Fell - Walk 18 holes with an assigned group of players. Standards are carried by the volunteer displaying the names of the players in each group along with the score totals. (*Youths recommended*) *Training Required*

Television: (Thursday-Sunday) Chair Person: Jim Fernandez - Assist television production crew. Responsibilities may include carrying sound equipment, spotting balls or relaying scores to TV truck. If possible we ask you work all day.

Tournament Office: (Pre-during and post tournament) Chair Person: Katy Andino - Assist with telephones, data entry, mailings and/or general office projects. Staffing needed 3 weeks prior to the tournament.

Uniform Packing and Distribution: (Pre and during tournament) Chair Person: Michelle Monhart - Uniform committee volunteers are needed before and during the tournament to inventory, pack, ship and distribute uniforms.

Volunteer Tent: (Thursday-Sunday) Chair Person: Janet Curran - Assist volunteers with food and refreshments. Help them check in and locate their assigned work area.

Golf Knowledge Required

Walking Scorer: (Thursday-Sunday) Chairs: Sharon Hasslen and Steve Duch - Must have an extensive knowledge of golf and be able to walk 18 holes. Record the scores and statistics for each player in your group. (*Limited Space Available*) *Training Required*

Stat Edit: (Thursday-Sunday) Chair Person: Mike Dispensa - Review LPGA Scoring statistics with walking scorers and reconcile with LPGA date.

Hole Reporter: (Thursday-Sunday) Chair Person: Mike Gorman - Uses radio to relay scores from greens back to scoring central. (*Training Required*)

Leader Board: (Thursday-Sunday) Chair Person: Mike Dispensa - Posts scores relayed by radio.

Scoring Tent: (Thursday-Sunday) Chair Person: Mike Dispensa - Receive score cards and copy them for runners.

Scoring Runner: (Thursday-Sunday) Chair Person: Mike Dispensa - Running scores from the scoring tents on the 18th and 9th green back to the scoring trailer. (*Youths Recommended*)
